Each community of practice will be facilitated by an upper-level administrator or senior faculty member (or a team of co-facilitators) from across Indiana. <p>Faculty Fellows Supports the development of engaged faculty scholars in a year-long learning community experience. <p>Research With and About Community Engagement Supports original research exploring community engagement initiatives in higher education, or the effect community engagement has on students' success during or after college. It funds research in partnership with community organizations/members on questions that arise from the community, or about the impact of community engagement on institutions and/or its stakeholders.</p>	<p>Open to: Senior Administrators, Faculty, Professional Staff, Doctoral Students Previous Award: Up to \$5,000 Previous Match: \$1,500 (or 30% of award) Funding Period: Typically 18 to 36 months</p>
