## Actualizing a Culture for Community Engagement

A 3-year grant to support institutions in deepening their community engagement by implementing holistic strategies intended to shift and broaden the culture for, and leverage their role as a place-based institution.

## Institutional Research and Student Success Learning Communities

A year-long learning community experience brings together institutional research or effectiveness offices and campus-community engagement initiatives to gain a better understanding of higher education's use of data and analytics for informing student success and community engagement initiatives.
