2021 Emerging Leaders in Community Engagement Award

The Indiana Campus Compact Emerging Leaders in Community award honors faculty and graduate teaching assistants from *multiple* Indiana Campus Compact partner institutions who are in the first seven years of their career who demonstrate leadership and innovation in advancing and shaping community engagement across the field.

The award is designed to recognize emerging engaged scholarship work, rather than long-established projects. The award recipient's work must have an established interest in the area or community that the award recipient seeks to benefit through their engaged scholarship effort. At a minimum, the award recipient will have laid the foundation for their work and established relationships with partnering organizations.

The goal of the award is to help early-career tenure-track and non-tenure-track faculty members build a lifetime of leadership in engaged scholarship work. We believe that each one of them deserves recognition at our annual Award Ceremony and there is more to be gained by bringing them all together to celebrate than to choose one over another. **All nominees will be honored at the annual Awards Ceremony.**

ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Be in the emerging phase of their academic career as a tenure-track or non-tenure-track faculty member on an [Indiana Campus Compact partner campus](#)
- And making unique and innovative contributions to the field of community engagement through work that has significant potential to advance engaged scholarship through teaching, research, and/or service.

PROCESS

Emerging leaders may be nominated by anyone on their campus.

Nominators, please submit the following:

- Nomination form (see below)

- Letter of nomination
- Two letters of support
- 250 word biography
- Print-ready digital photo
- Summary of nominee’s engagement (750 – 1,000 words) addressing the following:
 - Demonstrated leadership in and a passion for preparing undergraduate students to advance the public good
 - Demonstrated innovative practices and partnerships that lead to full participation for all students
 - Demonstrated collaborative leadership on campus and with community partners
 - Demonstrated deep understanding of the wider field of community engagement and a commitment to their own continuing professional development
 - Demonstrated significant potential to influence societal issues on local, regional, or national levels through their engaged scholarship work

CONDITIONS

- Nominations and supporting material are due May 15, 2020.
- The multiple award winners will be announced and recognized at the 2021 Indiana Campus Compact Summit and Annual Awards Luncheon (February 22, 2021). Nominee will be able to attend the Luncheon at no charge.
