



## **2022 Community Engagement Professional Award**

This award was created in 2006 to honor professional staff at Indiana Campus Compact partner institutions who demonstrate an ability to effectively cultivate, facilitate, and maintain high-quality partnerships with community organizations and representatives. This award recognizes Community Engagement Professionals' knowledge and ability to conceptually, ethically, and effectively represent the foundations of the field and the breadth of community-engaged work.

We recognize that Community Engagement Professionals (CEPs) are doing the critical work of empowering communities, securing community-based, co-educational environments to strengthen students' confidence, competency and self-efficacy, all while playing integral part of the anchor institution's movement toward creating a culture of engagement across academic and student affairs.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Full-time professional staff member from an Indiana Campus Compact partner institution who:

- Has worked toward embedding academic service-learning, community engagement, and/or co-curricular service across the institution's culture and values system
- Creates and strives toward a vision of community engagement for his/her/their campus
- Promotes higher education as a public good
- Provides exceptional support to faculty and students
- Has been instrumental in forming reciprocal and impactful campus-community partnerships

### **PROCESS**

Please submit the following:

- Nomination form (see below)
- Letter of nomination from an upper level administrator (preferably nominee's supervisor) detailing accomplishments in moving the institution toward embedding community engagement across the institutional culture and the promotion of higher education as a public good
- Two letters of support (should come from faculty, student, or community partner)
- A summary of programs, events, strategies, etc. nominee has implemented on campus (500 – 1,000 words)
- 250 word biography
- Print-ready digital photo
- A summary of nominee's engagement addressing their philosophy of community engagement as it relates to student learning, faculty advancement, and community

partnership (750 – 1,000 words)

## CONDITIONS

- Nominations and supporting material are due May 15, 2021.
- The award winner will be announced and nominees will be recognized at the Indiana Campus Compact Annual Awards Gala.

The winner will receive a plaque and a cash gift of \$500.00.
